Dignity At Home Program Guidelines:

- Be at least 60 years of age or disabled.
- At a risk of falling or have had a fall.
- Meet the monthly household income guidelines.
 - 1 person - \$3,263 or less
 - 2 people - \$3,729 or less

What The Program Involves:

- Phone interview to qualify.
- In-home environmental assessment.
- Education and information on fall prevention.
- If recommended, installation of injury prevention accessories.
